

Summary of Personal Protective Equipment Requirements G646o

When visiting symptomatic people and in close contact

No Symptoms: No PPE requirement

Personal Care Close Contact e.g. Occ Therapist, Norfolk First Support

- Surgical mask with ear loops
- Face Visor (if there is a risk of splashing of body fluids in the eyes only)
- 2 pairs of medical nitrile gloves
- Disposable apron
- Rubbish bags (tie handle or with separate ties)
- General-purpose detergent and chlorine based disinfectant solutions.
- Liquid soap and disposable hand towels
- Alcohol based hand sanitiser gel (for where hand washing facilities not available or suitable)



Close Contact e.g. Social Worker, Assistant Practitioner

- Surgical mask with ear loops
- Medical nitrile gloves
- Liquid soap and disposable hand towels
- Alcohol based hand sanitiser gel (for where hand washing facilities not available or suitable)
- Rubbish bags (tie handle or with separate ties)

Always ensure the use of PPE is combined with good infection control practice: hand hygiene, limiting contact with surfaces, catch it, bin it, kill it
